SUBMISSION

Brazilian Journalism Research is a semi-annual scientific journal published by the Brazilian Association of Journalism Researchers (SBPJor). The society is dedicated to theory and research in journalism (both theoretical and empirical work). The periodical has had a Portuguese version since the second semester of 2008.

Submission of works: preference will be assigned to empirical research reports; typed in double space throughout.

Articles: Should be originals and sent by means of the journal's system to the following electronic addresses:

After submission, the Brazilian authors undertake to send the English version of the work two weeks after the notice of acceptance, if the article is approved by the advisors. The foreign authors should also send the Portuguese version of the text two weeks after the notice of acceptance, if they receive a favorable opinion for publication of the article in BJR.

Each one of the two versions of the article (English and Portuguese) should have around 7 thousand words and should be typed in double space.

Each work should contain:

- A separate page with the title, the subtitle and the full name(s) of the author(s) with their current academic/professional affiliation and full residential and electronic mail address;
- An abstract of 100-150 words;
- Main text of about 7,000 words clearly organized, with a hierarchy of headings and subheadings and an easily readable style;
- Authors should also furnish five key words:
- References in both text and notes should be cited as (author, date, page);
- Footnotes should be displayed at the bottom of the page);
- Tables, figures, photos and illustrations should have a good

- range of contrast; they should also be numbered consecutively and must be clearly identified;
- A reference section in alphabetical order should follow the text; use the ABNT style;
- A short (up to 5 lines) biographical note should also be supplied on a separate sheet;
- Detailed guidance for the authors is attached in the document "Guide for Authors – Model for formatting articles to be submitted to BJR in Portuguese and in English", also available in the system;
- Permissions from copyright holders: authors are responsible for obtaining permissions from copyright holders for reproducing any quotation, illustration or photo previously published elsewhere.

Book reviews: the journal includes a section of reviews of books on Journalism and similar areas of up to 1,000 words. The texts should be written in a clear, easily readable style. We request that comments on books be sent to Célia Ladeira (cmmota@terra.com.br).
